

How to Connect With the Hazus Community

There are many ways to connect with the Hazus community, whether you want to collaborate with colleagues across the U.S., need technical support, or want to stay up-to-date on Hazus.

User Groups Calls (National and Regional)

In order to keep all Users engaged and up-to-date on Hazus information, the program holds monthly National Hazus User Groups calls. Each call focuses on a different topic, and features one or two speakers from the User community. In addition to the monthly National call, each group or Region conducts its own local User Group calls.
