What is the Hazus Technical Compendium?

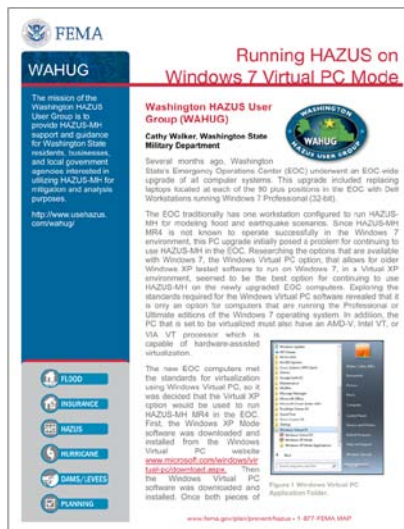
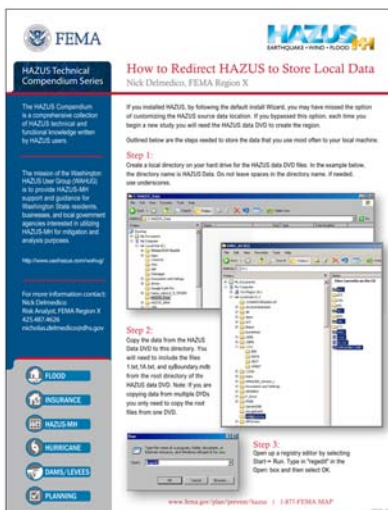
The Hazus Technical Compendium is a comprehensive collection of Hazus technical and functional knowledge articles written by Hazus users.
