DISCUSSION

Discussion: What direction do we want to take the HERC in?

- Kevin Mickey brought to the HERC the proposed idea that the HERC move in the direction of supporting the academic environment, in three areas:
 - Research
 - Teaching
 - Service
- It was discussed that in the academic environment teaching a specific tool such as Hazus is hardly ever done, the concept and the principals of GIS are taught rather than a specific tool. "Science continues technology expires."

It was proposed and decided that a model conceptual paper would be written, Kevin Mickey, Jamie Caplan and Silvana Croope would work on a draft of this paper. The idea behind this is a model for combining research, teaching and service learning into a group like the HERC. This conceptual paper will lay out the objectives and process of combining teaching, research and service learning.

- Bert asked if researchers at government facilities should be included in the HERC? YES.
- Seth mentioned needed funding at Loma Linda University to support expanding research related to Hazus.
- Silvana explained that the goal at DDOT is to use Hazus in real-time.

The Speakers Bureau is in the works. This will live on the HERC website and benefit all HUGs.

Kevin recommended that anyone that can attend the Higher Education Conference in June do so; as it is an invaluable resource.

HERC may collect Hazus curriculum resources for the academic community.
