- Reminded members to fill out the FEMA [HAZUS users survey](#). This survey only takes a minute to complete and will be invaluable for FEMA to assess the HAZUS user community needs and direct future development of the software.
- Spoke about the [two HAZUS posters](#) accepted into the 2009 ESRI Map Book. These were first displayed at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual FEMA HAZUS Conference in Raleigh in August, 2009.
- FEMA 4<sup>th</sup> Annual HAZUS Conference in Indianapolis, August 23 – 25, 2010. [Registration now opened.](#)
- HAZUS MR-5 currently in development. Details on release date not available. This release will have a coastal surge model.

- Currently in development is a HAZUS-MH Technical Support “Help Desk” application. Right now you have the [Help Line and Help emails](#) to answer your technical issues. The goal of the new “Help Desk” will be to streamline and enhance users’ technical support needs. Stay tuned for more information.
